IOWA LAKES REGIONAL WATER

NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION TO INSTITUTE PROCEEDINGS TO ENTER INTO A LOAN AGREEMENT AND BORROW MONEY IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,482,000 (WATER REVENUE)

The Board of Directors of Iowa Lakes Regional Water, State of Iowa (the "District"), will meet on the 15th of May, 2024, at the Iowa Lakes Regional Water Office, Spencer, Iowa, at 7:00 o'clock p.m., for the purpose of instituting proceedings and taking action to enter into a loan agreement and borrow money in a principal amount not to exceed \$2,482,000 (the "Loan Agreement") for the purpose of paying a portion of the cost of the District's Mallard Connection Project, as an improvement to the District's Rural Water System, including the addition to the existing Rural Water System to serve the City of Mallard (the "City") and paying other costs related to the expansion of the existing Rural Water System.

The Loan Agreement will not constitute a general obligation of the District, nor will it be payable in any manner by taxation, and the Loan Agreement, together with the outstanding water revenue obligations of the District and any additional water revenue obligations of the District may be hereafter issued and outstanding from time to time, ranking on a parity therewith, will be payable solely and only from the Net Revenues of the Rural Water System.

The Loan Agreement is proposed to be entered into pursuant to authority contained in Chapter 357A of the Code of Iowa. At the aforementioned time and place, oral or written objections may be filed or made to the Loan Agreement. After receiving objections, the Board may take action to enter into the Loan Agreement, in which case, the decision will be final unless appealed to the District Court within fifteen (15) days thereafter.

We, Bill Brown and Allen Stangl, landowners in Palo Alto County, and Jonathan P. Rosengren, engineer are the commissioners duly appointed to classify lands to Drainage District No. 61 N in Palo Alto County, Iowa. Pursuant to our appointment we have examined each benefited parcel within the district and as recommended in the engineer's report on file in the office of the County Auditor. Each 1/4 section or smaller tract of land within the district has been classified and the percentage of benefit each parcel derives from the several district facilities have been determined.

We recommend and report five new assessment schedules herein to be used for payment of future maintenance and other costs of each of the separate facilities as may arise. The existing main open ditch schedule as approved at establishment also remains in effect. Set beside the new schedules is a basis cost. This basis cost is assumed and should not be considered the cost of the completed work. We have appointed 18R basis to the lands determined to be benefited by each named facility to serve as a basis for the allocation of future costs associated with the named improvement.

Lateral 1 Open Ditch	\$100,000
Lateral 2 Open Ditch	\$100,000
Lateral 3 Open Ditch	\$100,000

Accordingly, we herewith submit our report. The schedule presents in tabular form for each benefited parcel:

- 1) The names of the owners thereof as shown on the transfer books in the Auditor's office
- 2) The parcel section, number, and description.
- 3) The number of benefited acres.
- 4) The classification or percentage of benefits derived relative to a 100% benefit assigned to the tract having the greatest benefit.

IT IS THE recommendation of the commissioners that this report be adopted.

WE ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the assessment schedule sets out a classification and assessment which shall be the basis for future repairs and improvements made in this District. The Board of Trustees for DD61 North has tentatively approved the report as filed and has fixed the time for hearing on said report for May 23rd, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. at the White House Fire Station.

WE ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that all objections to the Classification Report must be in writing and filed with the Kossuth or Palo Alto County Auditor at or before the time set for the hearing. This is not about "newspapers vs the internet". It's newspapers and newspaper websites vs government websites and newspaper websites have a much larger audience. Moving notice from newspapers to government websites would reduce the presence of public notices on the internet.

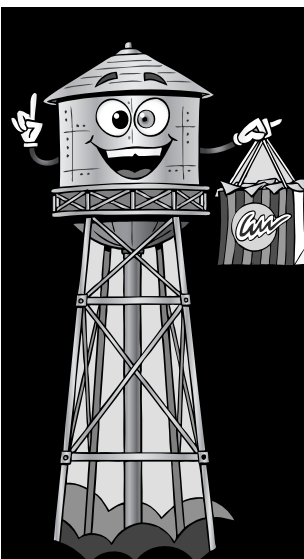

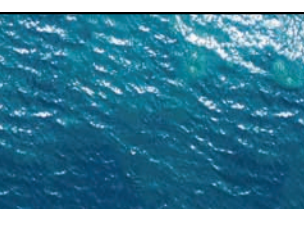
